

The purpose of this file is to see if punctuation which might be used in modern Korean text is present in a font.

In fontconfig, the preferred free serif fonts for Korean are Nanum Myeongjo, UnBatang and Baekmuk Batang. The preferred sans fonts are Nanum Gothic, UnDotum, Baekmuk Dotum and Baekmuk Gulim. Only the Nanum fonts are currently maintained.

It appears that full-width punctuation might be used.

For horizontal text, the ellipsis can be positioned at mid-level where a font only supports CJK and English. But the mid-line horizontal ellipsis (a mathematical symbol) is (since Unicode 14) the preferred way of showing the ellipsis at mid-level. Fonts such as the Noto CJK fonts get this wrong.

In theory semi-colons are not used. But I found one Korean site which used a semi-colon when explaining lorem ipsum.

Angle brackets and corner brackets can be used for titles. I'm using 'f-w' for 'full-width' to improve monospace e.g. NanumMyeongjo.
