

Linden Hill (Linden Hill.otf dated 2011-05-26)

This Old-Style font is based on Goudy Deepdene. It covers most European languages written in Latin alphabets (not the theoretically-encountered digraphs of Serbo-Croat).

For variations of the Latin alphabets I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

This document was prepared using X^ET_AX and fontspec. Depending on the font, missing glyphs will be replaced either by nothing at all (occasional fonts do that), a blank space, an empty box, or some other symbol indicating a missing glyph.

The letter forms used in italic fonts do not always match those used in regular fonts. Here is some English text to cover all letters: a quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dogs A QUICK BROWN FOX JUMPED OVER THE LAZY DOGS.

This font comes with a **SMALL CAPITALS** version (i.e. normal capitals with smaller ones replacing the lowercase), used in this example for quoting Death from the late Sir Terry Pratchett's discworld :

“ON A NIGHT LIKE THIS,” said Death, “THE ONLY CERTAIN THING IS UNCERTAINTY. Unfortunately, using a combining dot above on dotless i in small caps (needed for Turkish where both dotless and dotted i are used) has problems if a hyphen is applied after the i : see the example in the small caps file.

This font has only a regular weight in its normal and italic styles, and lacks small italic caps.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use '...' or ..." but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

left and right single quotes ‘...’
left and right double quotes “...”
single turned comma, right single quote ‘...’

double low 9 and left double quotes „...“
guillemets «...»
angle quotes <...>

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.
