Noto Sans Tifinagh (NotoSansTifinagh-Regular.ttf from Noto-hinted)

The English text in this document is set in Noto Sans, likewise the commas and full-stop in the tifinagh. As before, this is Article 1 of the UDHR.

Tifinagh script is used to write Berber languages - according to wikipedia it now has official status in Morocco, although a latin alphabet is also used. In Algeria either Tifinagh script or an arabic alphabet are used, although the latin alphabet is taught in schools. Source:
