

Old Standard (OldStandard-Regular.otf 2.0.2 (2008-11-24))

This Modern Serif font (inspired by the 'old' standard Russian font of the early 20th century) is intended for classical and mediaeval scholars. It is based on early 20th Century Russian and German fonts, but with some glyphs using French Didot forms.

It covers most European languages written in Latin, some Cyrillic, and Greek alphabets.

For variations of the Latin and Cyrillic alphabets and for monotonic Greek I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

The normal style has regular and bold weights, the italic style has only a regular weight but covers all the languages.

Some people continue to use polytonic Greek for cultural reasons.

There are far too many available variants for me to list here — I suspect that some have fallen out of use, but I do not know which. There are similar, but smaller, ranges of diacriticals for the other vowels and also for the letter ρ.

4 Quotation-marks, etc.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use ‘...’ or “...” but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

left and right single quotes ‘...’	double low 9 and left double quotes „...“
left and right double quotes “...”	guillemets «...»
single turned comma, right single quote ‘...’	angle quotes <...>

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.
