

Sawarabi Gothic (SawarabiGothic.ttf dated 2024/09/04)

This Japanese Sans font was designed to work well in small text sizes. It covers some languages written in a Latin alphabet, Russian, and Japanese, but it lacks some combining-diacriticals needed for certain non-European Latin alphabets.

For variations of the Latin and Cyrillic alphabets I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

This font has a regular weight in normal style.

This font has only 4,469 Kanji glyphs. According to Omniglot regarding learning a language, knowledge of about 2,000 Kanji (with Hiragana, Katakana) is sufficient to read most Japanese texts, whereas Chinese needs between 4,000 and 5,000 Hanzi. In practice, several Kanji which I test for are missing.

This font lacks the OpenType tags 'hani' , 'cyrl' needed to use polyglossia for CJK or Cyrillic scripts.

## 4 Other variants of the Latin alphabet

There are many more variations of the Latin alphabet in official use throughout the world. Particularly in African countries, and also for Vietnamese, some fonts which are otherwise good may have problems. In particular, this font lacks the combining below dot needed for the Pan-Nigerian alphabet, and some of the combining accents to show tones for the horned letters in Vietnamese.

### 4.1 Lingala (parts of the Congos, Angola, Central African Republic)

This is a tonal language, using accents: no accent for default low tone, acute accent for the high tone, circumflex for descending tone, caron for ascending tone

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use ' ...' or " ..." but in good text there are variations and this font supports:
