

This Transitional Serif font covers all my test European languages using Latin alphabets, Vietnamese, all my test languages using Cyrillic alphabets, and monotonic Greek.

Vollkorn intends to be a quiet, modest and high quality text face for bread and butter use. Unlike many text typefaces from the Renaissance period until now, it has dark and meaty serifs and a bouncing and healthy look. It might be used in body copy, or just as well for headlines and titles. »Vollkorn« is German for "wholemeal" which refers to the old term »Brotschrift«. That stood for the small fonts for every day use in hand setting times.

For variations of the Latin and Cyrillic alphabets and for monotonic Greek I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

The letter forms used in italic fonts do not always match those used in regular fonts. Here is some English text to cover all letters: a quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dogs A QUICK BROWN FOX JUMPED OVER THE LAZY DOGS.

This font comes with a **SMALL CAPITALS** version (i.e. normal capitals with smaller ones replacing the lowercase), used in this example for quoting Death from the late Sir Terry Pratchett's discworld :

This font has regular and italic styles in normal and bold weights.

It has small caps for Latin and Cyrillic alphabets, and italic small caps for Latin alphabets.

Most exceptionally, the dimensions of the small caps appear to be well specified, and I can show the creation of the individual Vietnamese tone markings for small caps in a fairly reasonable fashion without altering the spacing.

The interesting features of Vietnamese are the use of horns on 'o' and 'u' to provide additional vowels, and the use of diacriticals to show the tone. The letters themselves are pre-composed, but displaying some of the individual tone markings requires combining accents.

single turned comma,

with right single quote '...'

double low 9 and left double quotes „...“

guillemets «...»

angle quotes <...>

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.
