2 GREEK ALPHABET

Although small caps are provided for monotonic Greek, none of the vowels have tonos or dialytika, which I think makes them not useful.

3 Other variants of the Latin alphabet

The hyphen on the first line overflows into the margin.

Throughout the world thereere are many more variations of the Latin alphabet in official use. Particularly in African countries, some fonts which are otherwise good may have problems. For some of the African languages it is necessary to use combining diacriticals.

The position of the combining diacriticals on Epsilon and Open-O makes this font very poor for use with Dinka and Lingala. The small caps omit some letters for Ewe and the Pan-Nigerian alphabet.

3.1 VIETNAMESE

The interesting features of Vietnamese are the use of horns on 'o' and 'u' to provide additional vowels, and the use of diacriticals to show the tone. The letters themselves are pre-composed, but displaying some of the individual tone markings requires combining accents.

4 QUOTATION-MARKS, ETC.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use '...' or ..." but in good text there are variations and this font supports:
